- e) Explain the relationship between research designs, sampling and data collection methods/instruments (5 marks)
- f) Explain five main factors that influence the response rate (5 marks)
- g) State sources of literature review. Give examples (2 marks)

#### **QUESTION TWO (20 MARKS)**

- a) Explain any five characteristics of a good problem statement (5 marks)
- b) Discuss four types of research as classified by Patton (2002) (4 marks)
- c) Explain five main research designs (5 marks)
- d) State two sources of knowledge apart from research (2 marks)
- e) Discus the two reasons for conducting pilot study. Give examples (4 marks)

#### **QUESTION THREE (20 MARKS)**

- a) Discuss any two referencing methods within the text (4 marks)
- b) Explain how useful will the results of a study be, to different stakeholders. Consider at least three stakeholders (6 marks)
- c) Using a well labeled diagram, show the steps used in conducting research. Briefly state the main highlights of the first three chapters of a research proposal (10 marks)

#### **QUESTION FOUR (20 MARKS)**

- a) Questionnaire is a set of standard questions (question schedule) and these questions are asked systematically (structured) or some leeway (semi structured). Explain common rules of constructing a good questionnaire? (10 marks)
- b) Discuss the importance of conducting a review of the literature in the research process (10 marks)
