INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. You should have the following items for this examination:
 - a) Plain light weigh fabric 2m by 114cm wide.
 - b) Easy fitting bodies and sleeve blocks size 10.
 - c) Fusible interfacing 30cm * 50cm.
 - d) Bias binding 1.5m long.
 - e) Lace 1" (one inch) wide by ½ meter long
 - f) Sewing thread to match the fabric.
 - g) Brown papers
 - h) Sewing tools
 - i) Drafting tools
 - i) One button 1.5cm wide without shank
 - k) One large envelope
- 2. At the end of this examination:
 - a) Stich on a label bearing your name and index number on single layer of fabric without concealing any details.
 - b) Enclose the garment in the large envelope and hand over to the examiner.

Task

- 3. Using the bodice block, sleeve block and the measurement provided, cut out and make the garment style sketched below as follows:
 - a) Use French seem at the sides and under arm seams;
 - b) Use extended facing at the opening;

- c) Use separate facing for the back opening;
- d) Bind the sleeve hem;
- e) Sandwich the lower front into the double yoke.
- f) Make one button hole at the collar and attach the button.

Measurements

Collar depth - 3cm
Full length - 58cm
Sleeve length - 21cm
