- c) Explain three (3) major implications to the teaching-learning process of Piaget's theory of cognitive development (6 marks)

- a) Define the meaning of the term **personality** as used in Developmental Psychology (2 marks)
- b) Explain three (3) strengths and two (2) weaknesses of the following theories of personality development: (10 marks)
